



- Use of informatics and transparency provides a vision of modern, accountable social assistance












- Sets schedule for developing costed local plans and bi-annual S-S conference







  - conditional vs non-conditional,

- Continuation of 'first generation' how-to issues, especially in low income countries
- Resurgence of interest in making SSN more "productive" via links to nutrition, education, labor markets, micro-finance, agriculture, etc.
