



## Preparation

### PREPARATION OVERVIEW

The aim of this phase is to lay the foundation for a successful program implementation. It is worth taking the time to carry out these tasks well as they can be make-or-break factors for successful implementation. A solid team and strong partnerships can go a long way in making implementation smoother and ensuring more efficient use of resources.

During preparation, all of the ground work necessary for the successful delivery of the program is required to be planned, implemented and completed. Without a solid foundation, the program should not be launched.

The other 4 stages of the Fund delivery can be found in the menu above.
