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

- EUR 54.5 million grant, funded by the European Union (through 10th EDF intra-ACP envelope for DRR)

Strengthen regional & sub-regional cooperation to advance ACP countries' national DRR agendas



Funds received: EUR 49 million







February 2014 Bujumbura lake outburst and flash floods event

- 80 mm of heavy rainfall in Bujumbura on Feb 9
- 10-y return period event
- Lake outburst & flash flooding responsible for 69 casualties
- Assessment conducted early March identified USD 20 million immediate/medium term and USD 160 million in long term needs
- WB discussing with GoB a follow-up Crisis Response Window support (20-25 million USD)













Belize: National Climate Resilience Investment Plan


- Supports to Hazard and Risk Assessment Framework



Pacific Catastrophe Risk Assessment and Financing Initiative - PCRAFI




