



**Junior Economist/Economic Analyst
(Warsaw based position)**

The Macroeconomics and Fiscal Management Global Practice (MFM GP) of the World Bank is seeking to recruit an outstanding **Junior Economist** to work on the World Bank program in Poland and other countries of Central Europe. The position is based in Warsaw.

The Economist will monitor, analyze and report on economic developments, contribute to analytical work and economic reports produced by the larger economic team, draft documents about macroeconomic and fiscal policy issues, process data and maintain Bank's databases. The Economist is expected to interact with government officials, non-government organizations, the private sector and academia.

The position requires a minimum of a Master's degree in economics, with at least three years of professional experience, superior technical skills (including proficiency in using MS Excel and advanced statistical software), first-rate interpersonal and communication skills (fluency in spoken and written English and Polish), ability to work independently and in a team.

This appointment is through a short-term consultancy contract initially made for six months commencing on or around June 1, 2015, and is renewable for longer periods subject to candidate's performance.
