

School based management is a decentralization process




How do we ensure that a decentralized education system translates into better learning outcomes?


Autonomy – Accountability – Assessment

Mexico's Programa Escuelas de Calidad (PEC)

- According to Murnane et al (2006), PEC improved social participation, transparency and accountability and it led to a reduction in dropout rates.
- However, there was no evidence of a positive effect of PEC on learning outcomes. → WHY?




School directors' managerial practices and learning outcomes




World Management Survey (WMS)

is an instrument to measure managerial capacities


