CICED was established on July 14th, 2008 by decree of the Russian Federation.


CICED's aim is the coordination and execution of work on initiatives designed to help international development in education, particularly through aid to developing countries.





CICED promotes the SAM tool

SAM (School Achievements Monitoring) – test tool to asses students' subject competencies. SAM model is laid by theory of L.Vygotskiy. At this stage SAM tests for primary school graduates are developed for Mathematics and Russian language.

Functional level

procedural knowledge - knowledge of specific algorithms and standard procedures that have been directly taught

Reflexive level

conceptual understanding - understanding how to solve a whole range of problems related to the same concept

Formal level

functional competence - conceptual flexibility that allows to see a full range of possible solutions and identify the best Zone of Proximal Development







Future of SAM development – grant application to GPE from Russia

Global Partnership for Education (GPE, former FTI) is a global multilateral trust fund for educational development aid (over 3 billion dollars)

GPE Board of directors approved CICED's application for the GRA grant to conduct the research on the influence of teaching practices and methods on the development of students' reasoning skills

Possible of country partners - Armenia, Kyrgyzstan, Moldova, Mongolia, Tajikistan, Uzbekistan
