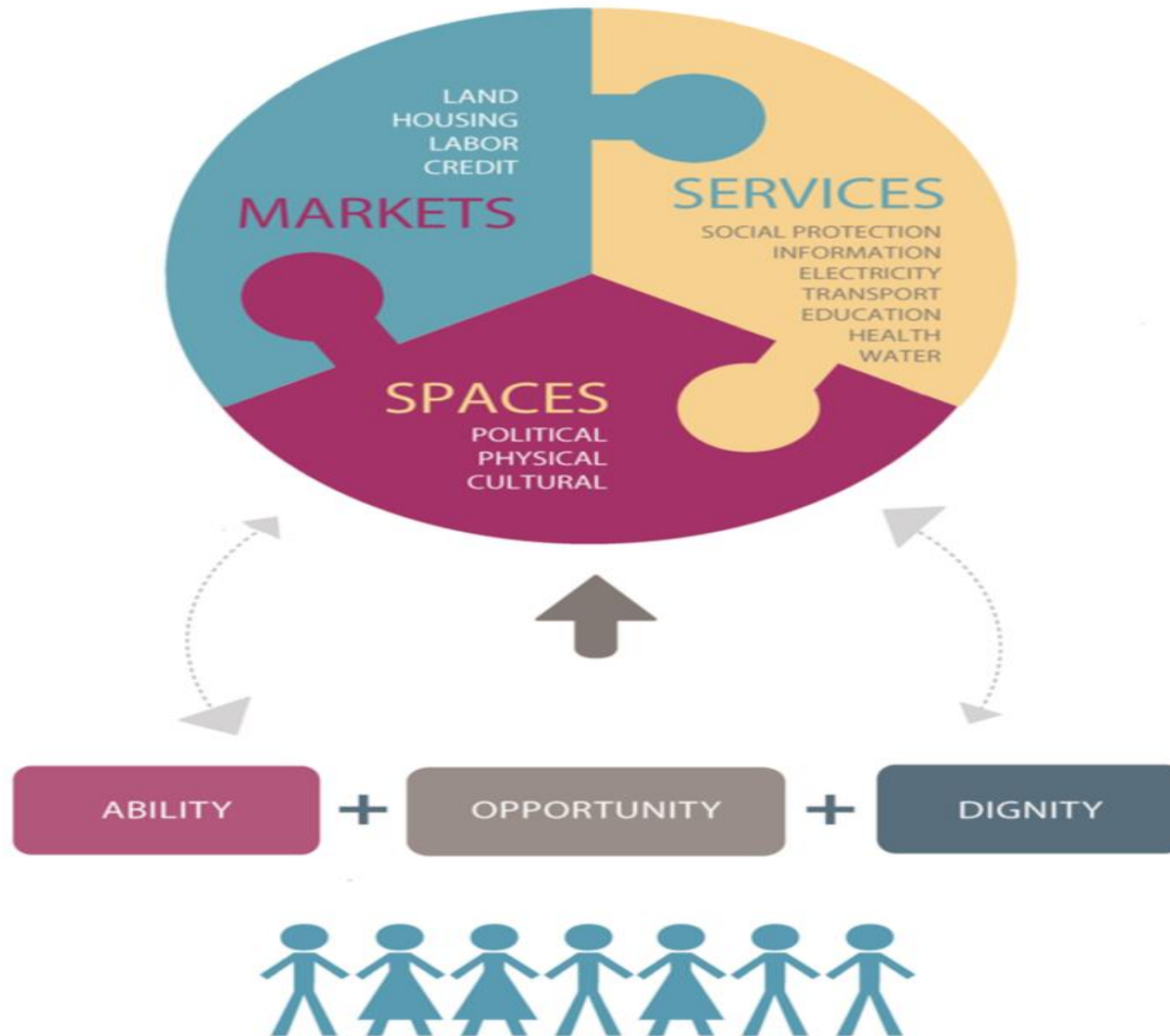

Social Inclusion

- The process of improving the **terms** for **individuals and groups** to take part in society
- The process of improving the **ability, opportunity and dignity** of **people disadvantaged on the basis of their identity** to take part in society

Inclusion in what?



How we measured Social Inclusion in Bank's projects (FY10-13)

- **Criterion I:** **Identify** groups excluded based on their **identity** and their **disadvantage**
- **Criterion II:** **Actions** addressing exclusion or **monitoring** the results of capturing positive effects on the excluded
- **Criterion III:** **Beyond a do-no-harm** approach

We are **evaluating** only the **project design** – not the implementation

Addressing Disability Based Exclusion

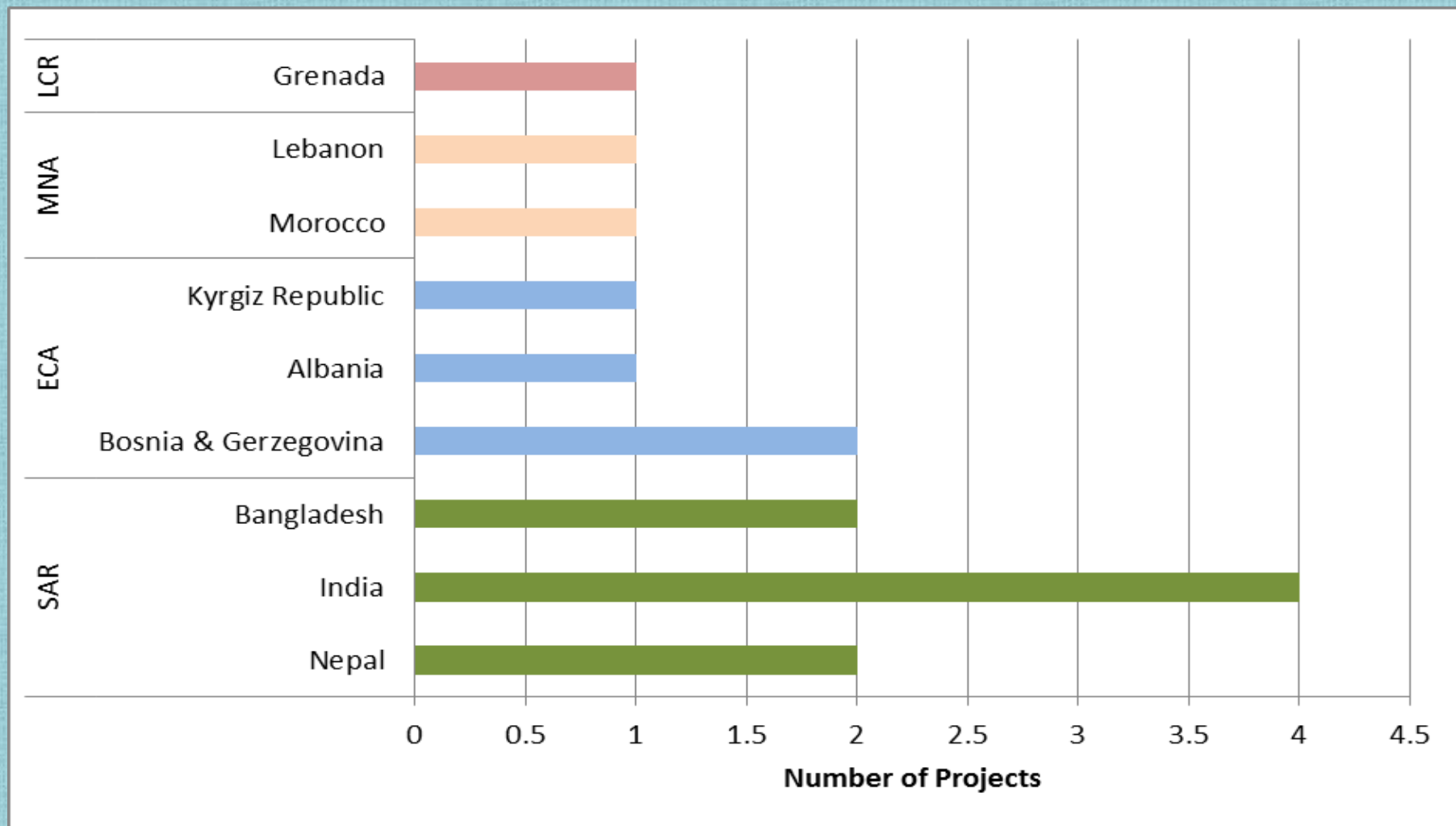
- **From 138 Projects that address Social Inclusion issues, 15 projects (11%) pertain to PWD**
- Out of these 15 projects, 3 were identified as good practice case studies

How ?

- The majority of the projects identify PWD as part of marginalized or vulnerable groups
- Some projects use the approach of mobilization of PWD into Self-Help Groups
- A few have M&E with specific targets to reach the differently abled.

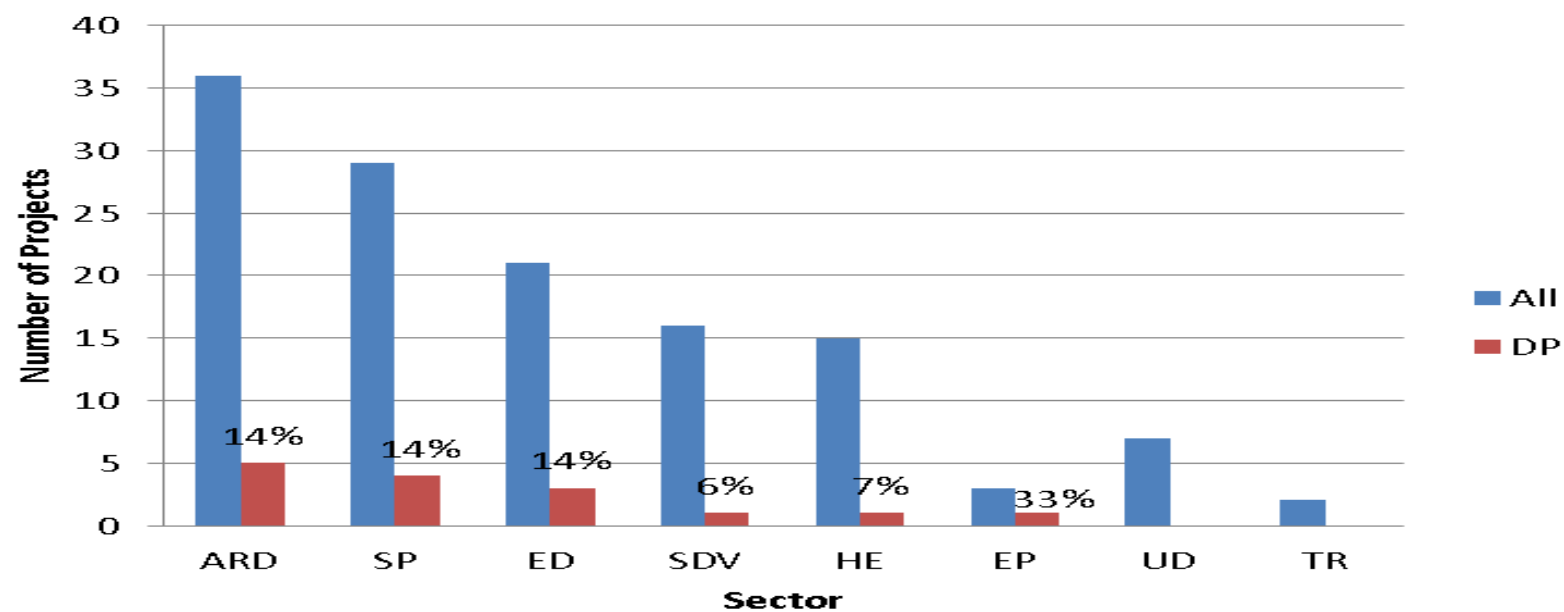


Projects by Region

Health and Social Protection Project (Kyrgyz Republic)

Primary target:

Households with special needs/disabilities

Identified disadvantaged:

- no opportunities for meaningful rehabilitation or social integration,
- No systems to support individuals' social integration

Key Features:

- Revised Disability Certification according to modern approaches. Focus on *abilities* and opportunities for rehabilitation
- Address multiple causes and dimensions of vulnerability
- Design community-based infrastructure and services to enable PWD to function in society.
- Community-based integrated social services & day care centers using one-stop-shops



The Total War Against HIV and AIDS (TOWA) Project

The Samburu Handicapped Ed. and Rehabilitation Program

- Pastoralists of Samburu are nomadic
- Children with disabilities and HIV/AIDS are abandoned

key features:

- ❖ Train health workers on disability issues
- ❖ Provide nutrition, health and home care services to 150 disabled children living with HIV/AIDS
- ❖ 45 children have been fully rehabilitated and reintegrated to their families.
