WHO



The World Bank Group (WBG) Youth Summit Organizing Committee, comprised of younger WBG employees and supported by WBG Senior Management, has revitalized the WBG's engagement with a dynamic generation of young people who are interested in global youth-related issues.

The Youth Summit was established in 2013 to enhance the World Bank Group's commitment to the concerns of global youth and to empower youth to find their own innovative ideas for development. Given its success in 2013 and 2014, the Youth Summit is now an annual event that serves as a platform for conversation and action between youth, the WBG and the international community.



WHAT



On November 16 + 17, the WBG Youth Summit 2015 will convene youth leaders, climate change experts, development and private sector professionals, government officials and students to discuss young peoples role in the fight against climate change.

A major component of the event is the case competition which was launched on September 3rd, 2015 and will run through October 3rd, 2015. The selected finalist will be invited to present their proposals to a live audience and a jury of experts. The jury will select the winning proposal which will be announced at the closing ceremony along with a People's Choice Winner determined by the audience.

Additionally, the Youth Summit will provide training on climate change related topics for all attendees. Topics include: Sustainable Cities, Energy Efficiency, Climate Smart Agriculture, Climate Resilience, Climate Finance, Landscapes, Water Scarcity and Green Transport and ICT

WHY



Given the risk that climate change poses to the wellbeing of our planet and people, and with the upcoming United Nations Framework Convention on Climate Change (UNFCCC) from 30 November – 11 December 2015, the Youth Summit Organizing Committee (YSOC), has identified the following topic for the Youth Summit 2015: *If Not Us Then Who: Crowd-Sourcing Solutions for Climate Change*.

The event will focus on giving young people the opportunity to share their innovative ideas on how to mainstream climate change in a WBG client country.
