 - Support of control entities

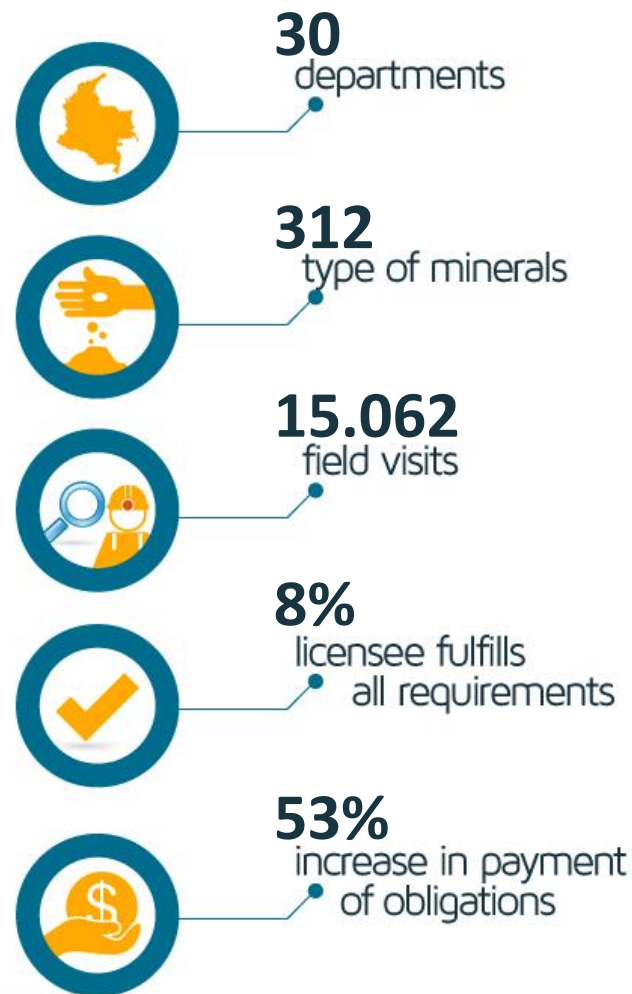

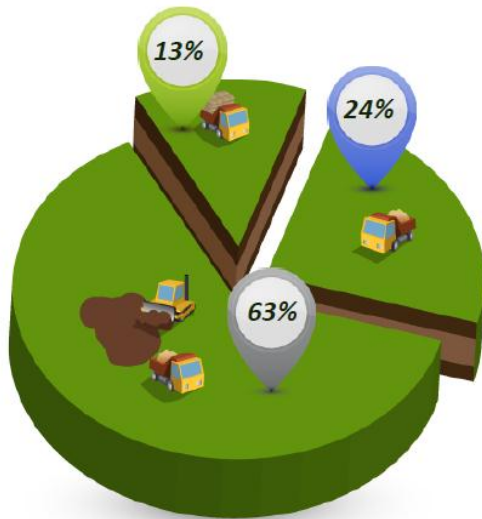

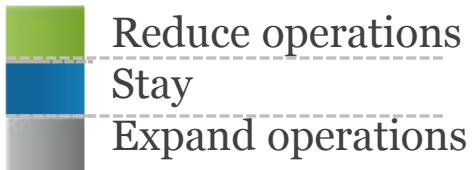

Within the next 5 years



- Within the next years, **63% of mining companies** intend to **expand operations**
- **66%** considers mining to be **positive for the country**
- **78%** believe that “well done” mining generates development in the regions
- **63% believe** that it is possible to have a **socially responsible mining activity**

MINING IS A KEY DRIVER FOR THE 4G INFRASTRUCTURE PROJECT

- **High level support of strategic projects**
 - CONPES PINES (3,762)
 - Timely and effective management in order to make possible the future of Induprimas – Peldar and Sumicol – Corona
- **Implementation of public works** in roadway corridors, ports infrastructure, rivers and railways
- **Supporting title owners** in implementing social clauses



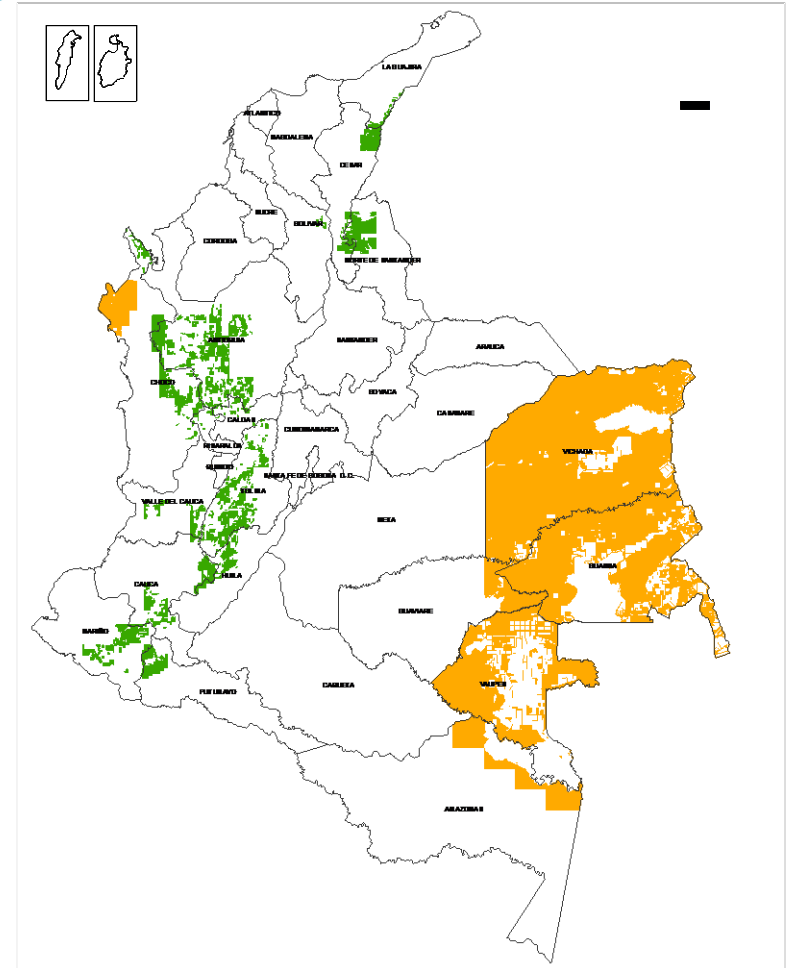
THE GOVERNMENT IS IMPROVING THE PROCESS IN PRIOR CONSULTATION

Improvement in prior consultation with the indigenous and Afro-descendant peoples

- ✓ **Presidential Directive** to implement a guide
- ✓ **Inter-institutional Coordination Protocol** (Decree 2613/2013)
- ✓ **Creation** of inter-institutional committees
- ✓ **Simplification of process** to obtain the certificate of presence of indigenous and Afro-descendant peoples (The Ministry of Interior)
- ✓ **Expediting** legalization of prior consultation. Now with The Ministry of Interior (before, with ANLA)
- ✓ In process, **single window tool (“ventanilla única”)** to follow environmental and social stages in projects.

STRATEGIC MINING AREAS

- **Collaborative effort** by several entities (Ministry of Mines, Geological Service, UPME, ANM)
- **Support of World Bank** in constructing tender methodology
- Data collection by the **Colombian Geological Service**
- Data diffusion policy
- **Tender procedures** (preparing information, launch and opening, qualification, award)
