The annualized growth rate is computed as  $(\text{Mean in year 2}/\text{Mean in year 1})^{1/(\text{Year 2} - \text{Year 1})} - 1$ . c. Refers to the year in which the underlying household survey data was collected and, in cases for which the data collection period bridged two calendar years, the year in which most of the data was collected is reported. The initial year refers to the nearest survey collected 5 years before the most recent survey available, only surveys collected between 3 and 7 years before the most recent survey are considered. The final year refers to the most recent survey available between 2009 and 2013. d. Denotes whether the data reported is based on consumption (c) or income (i) data. e. Covers urban areas only. f. Based on benchmark national PPP estimate re-scaled to account for cost-of-living differences in urban and rural areas.
