Where we are

Supply side Investments in Quality Education:

- Reforming the education administration system (structure, processes, incentives)
- Reforming the education financing system
- Improvement in national education standards and curriculum
- Publication of textbooks and teaching materials
- Training and advanced training of teachers in **general education** schools
- Capacity building in schools and the educational system overall

Demand side Investments in Quality Education:

- Putting in place support and incentive frameworks for children and their families in order to improve education coverage and school attendance
- Mobilization of **PTAs**



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Where we are (Continued)

Assessment of education quality:

- Establish a Department for the Assessment of Student Proficiency (ASP), and build up its capacity
- Conduct a pilot ASP
- Establish a *National Testing Center* (NTC)

Tajikistan

What we want to achieve in 5 years

An adequately equipped and fully functional National Testing Center that administers:

- **Impartial and transparent exams for enrolling in institutions of higher education**
- **Standardized national assessments of student proficiency for general education schools**



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What we want to achieve in 10 years

- An established, sustainable system of free and fair nationwide exams for all citizens of the country that wish to enroll in institutions of higher education
- Setting up a system for assessing student proficiency at various levels of education
- Participation in international proficiency assessment programs (TIMSS, PISA)
- Setting up a system and framework for modernizing national standards, the curriculum, textbooks and the training/retraining of teachers based on the results of (national and international) assessments of student proficiency

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Problems

- Funding
- Capacity
- Resistance (Behavioral)
- Corruption
- Low proficiency level of students and prospective students applying for admission to a university
