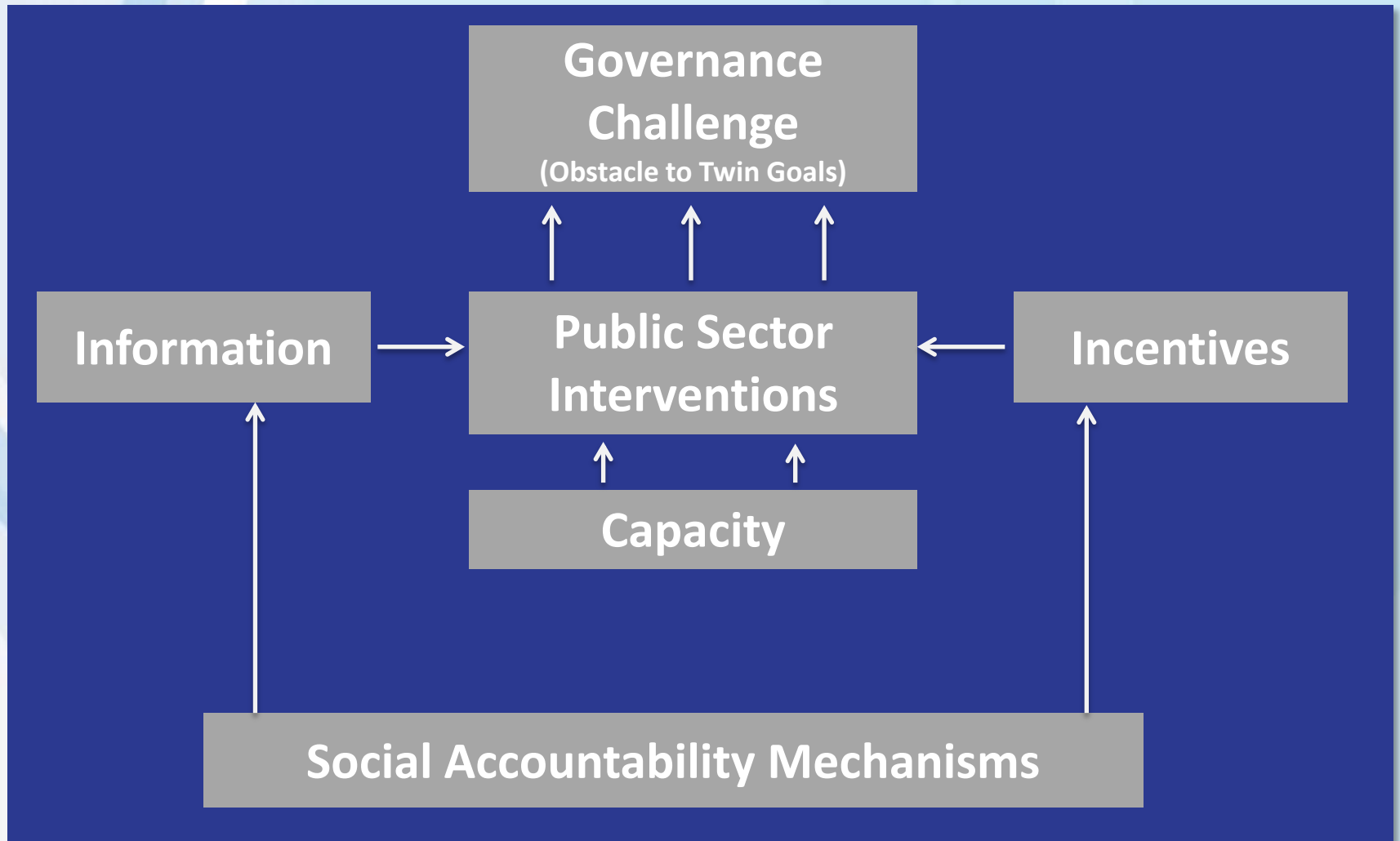

Background & Vision

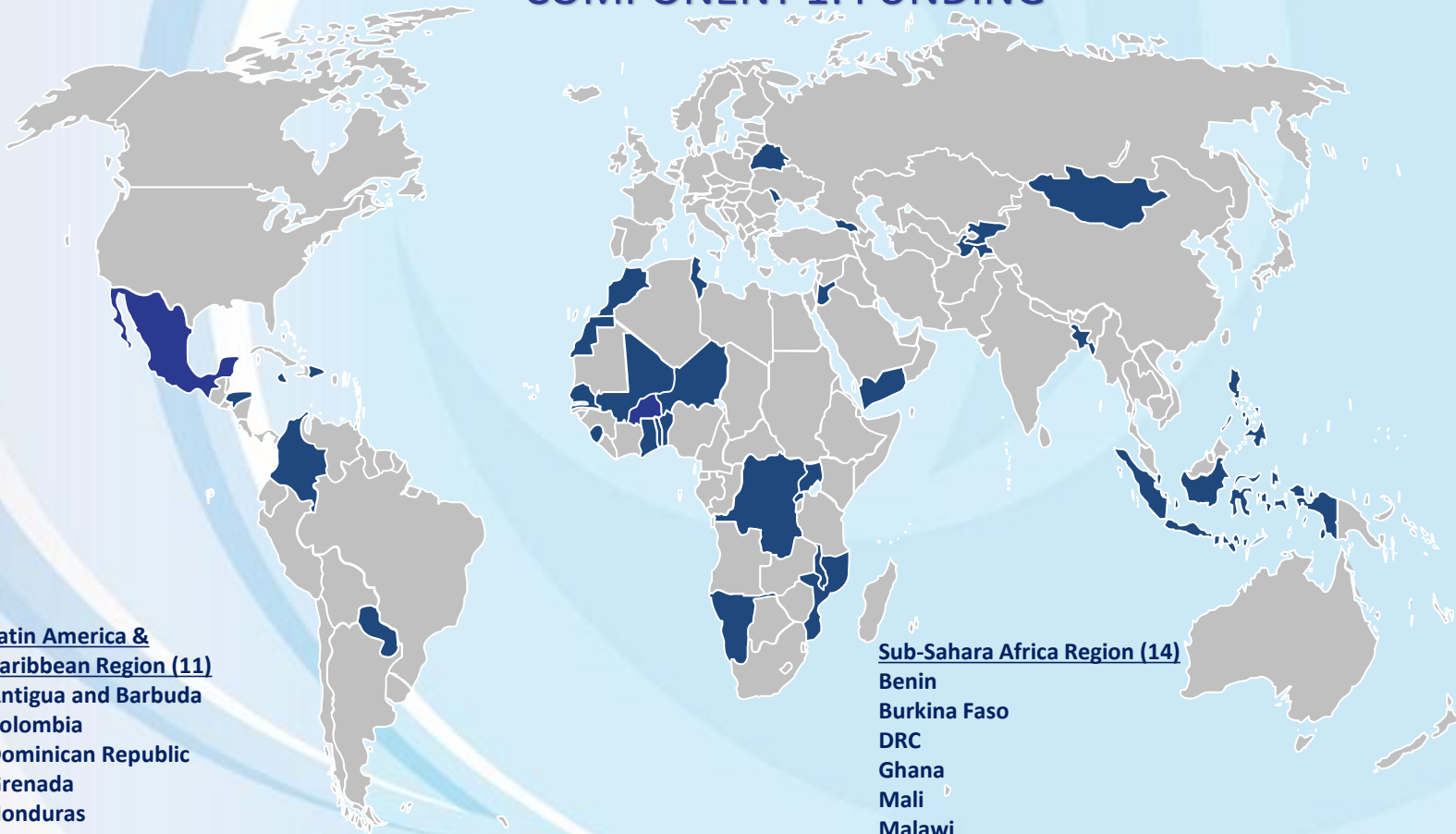
- Extensive consultations with over 1,300 stakeholders worldwide

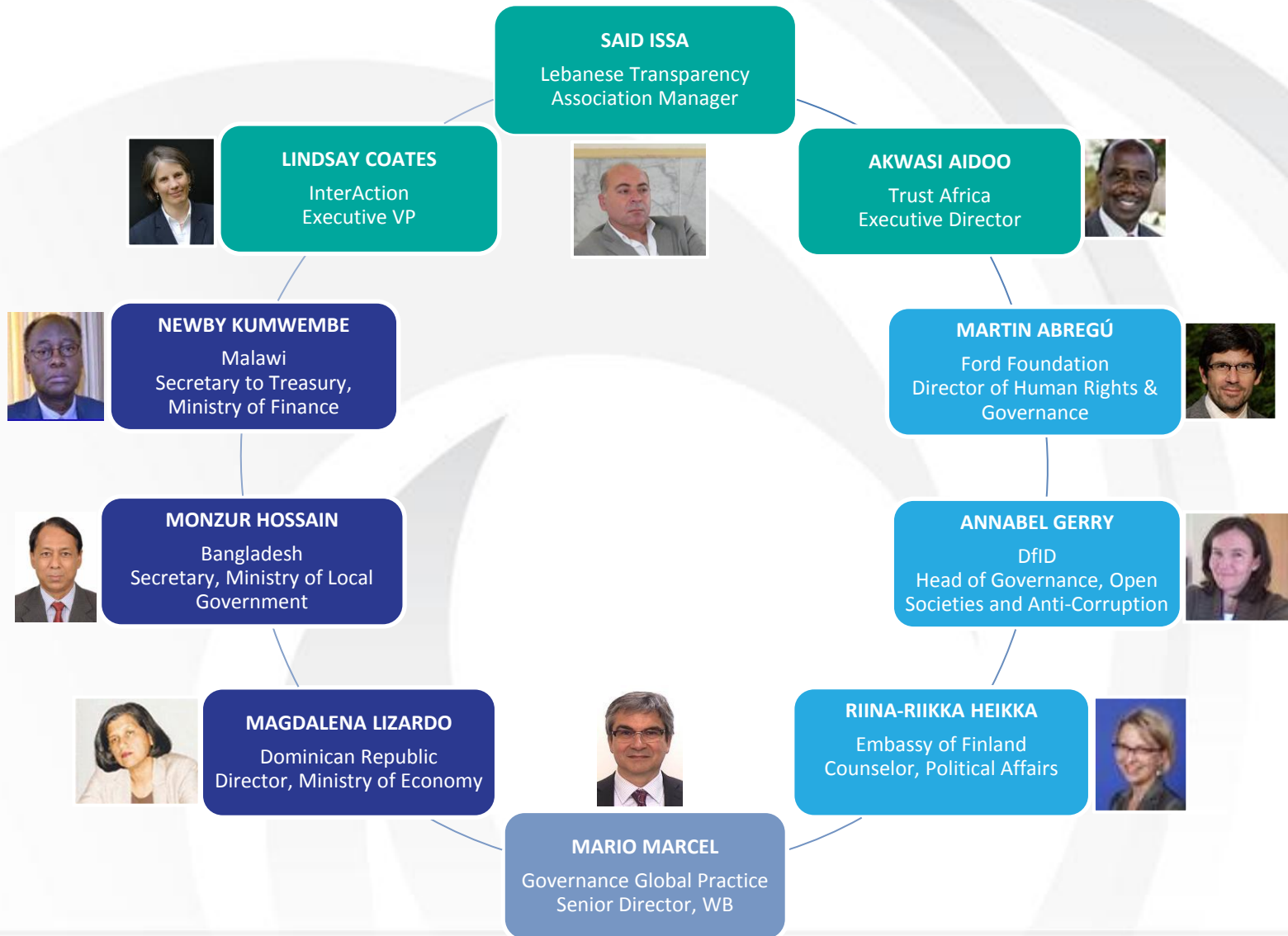

GPSA Component 1: Funding

- Grants for programmatic activities on social accountability, capacity building and institutional strengthening
- Disbursement against milestones
- Global Call for Proposals in opted-In countries
 - 1st Call: launched February 2013, grantees selected
 - 2nd Call: launched November, 2013, finalists selected
- US\$ 500K – 1M for periods of 3-5 years

A Problem-Solving Approach

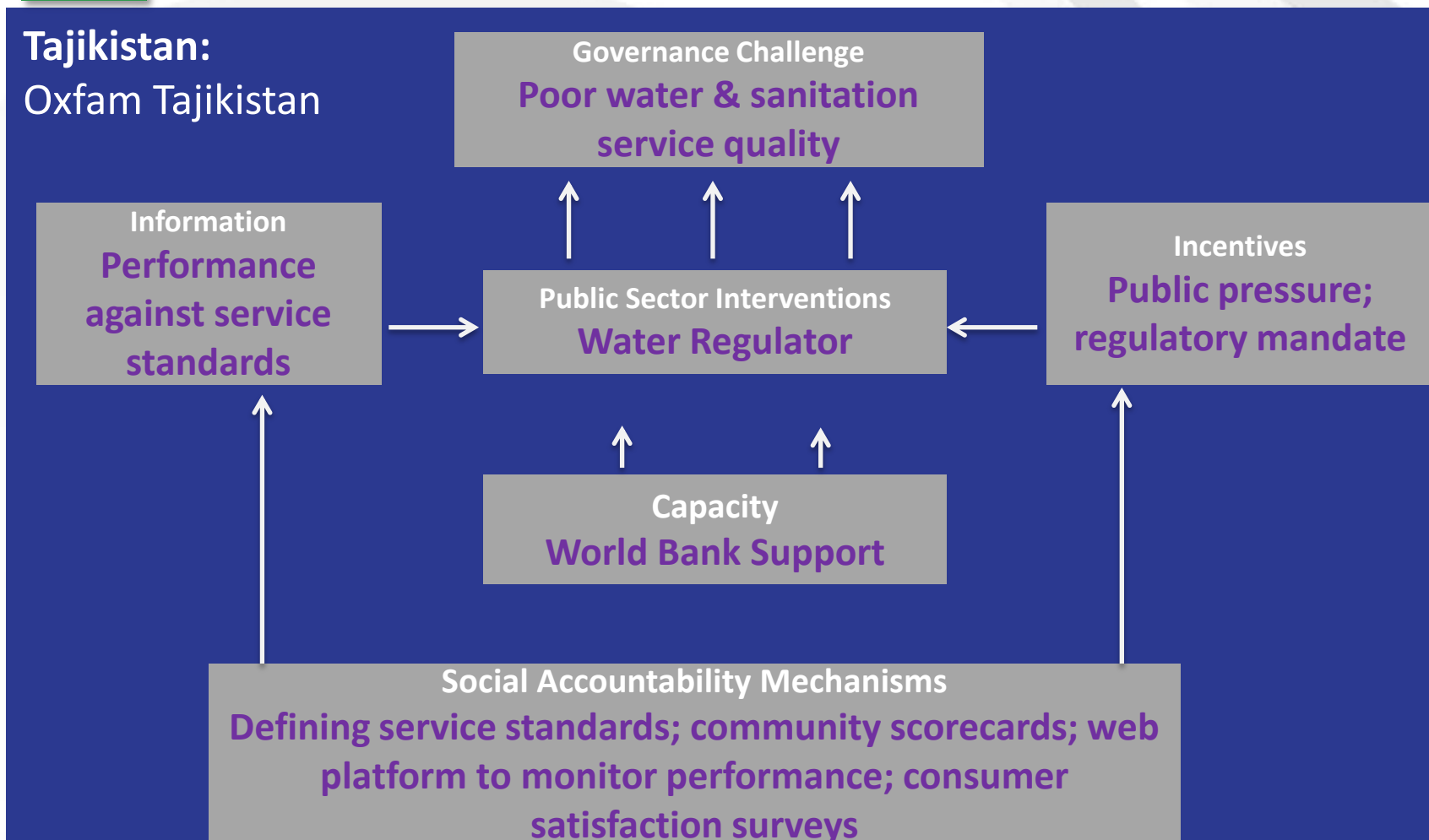
- Focus on addressing real problems and delivering results
- Ensure that the citizens' feedback is used by a public entity to address a specific governance issue ('information loop')
- World Bank helps Governments respond to citizen feedback
- Strengthen cooperation between reform champions

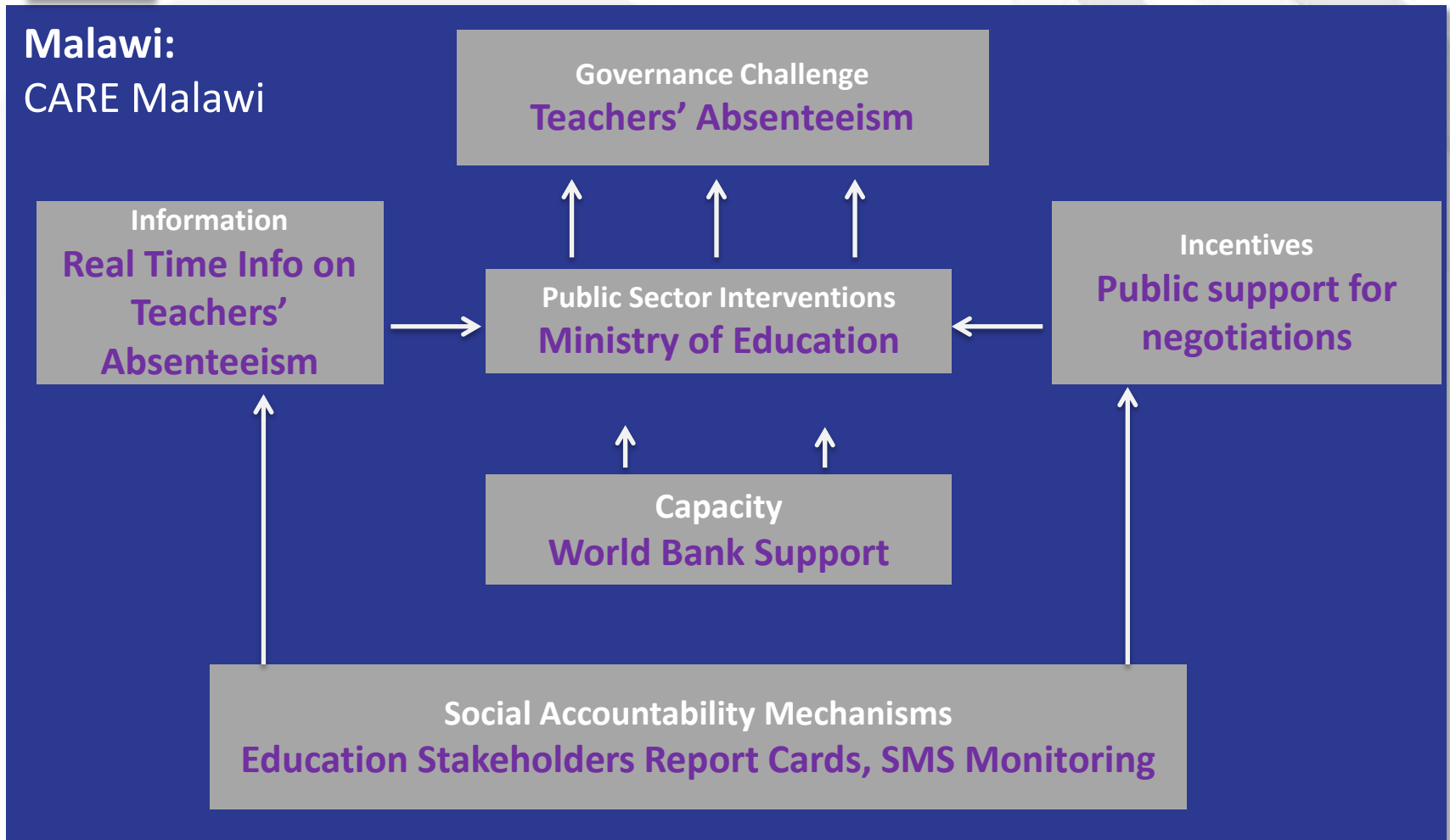

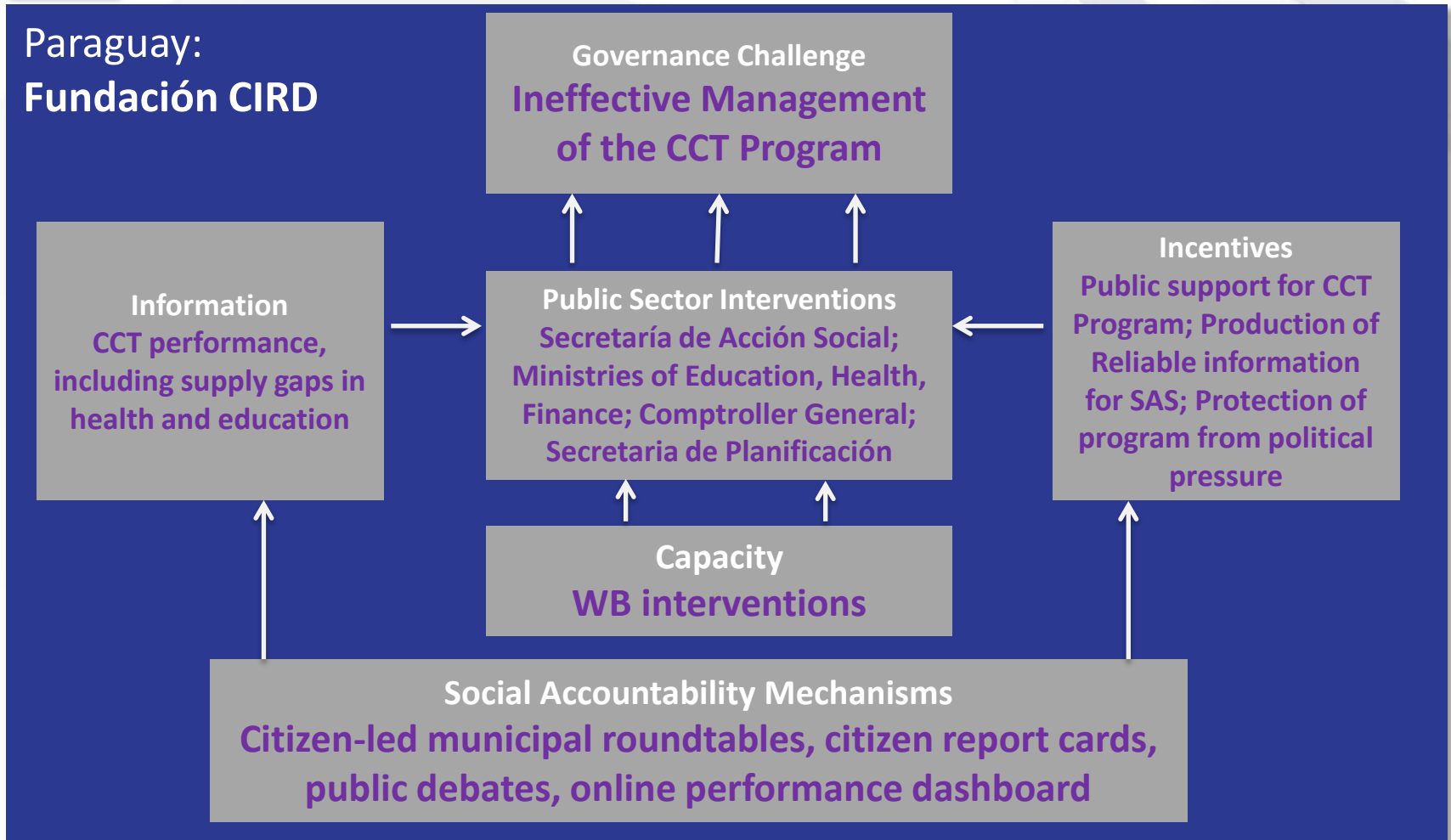

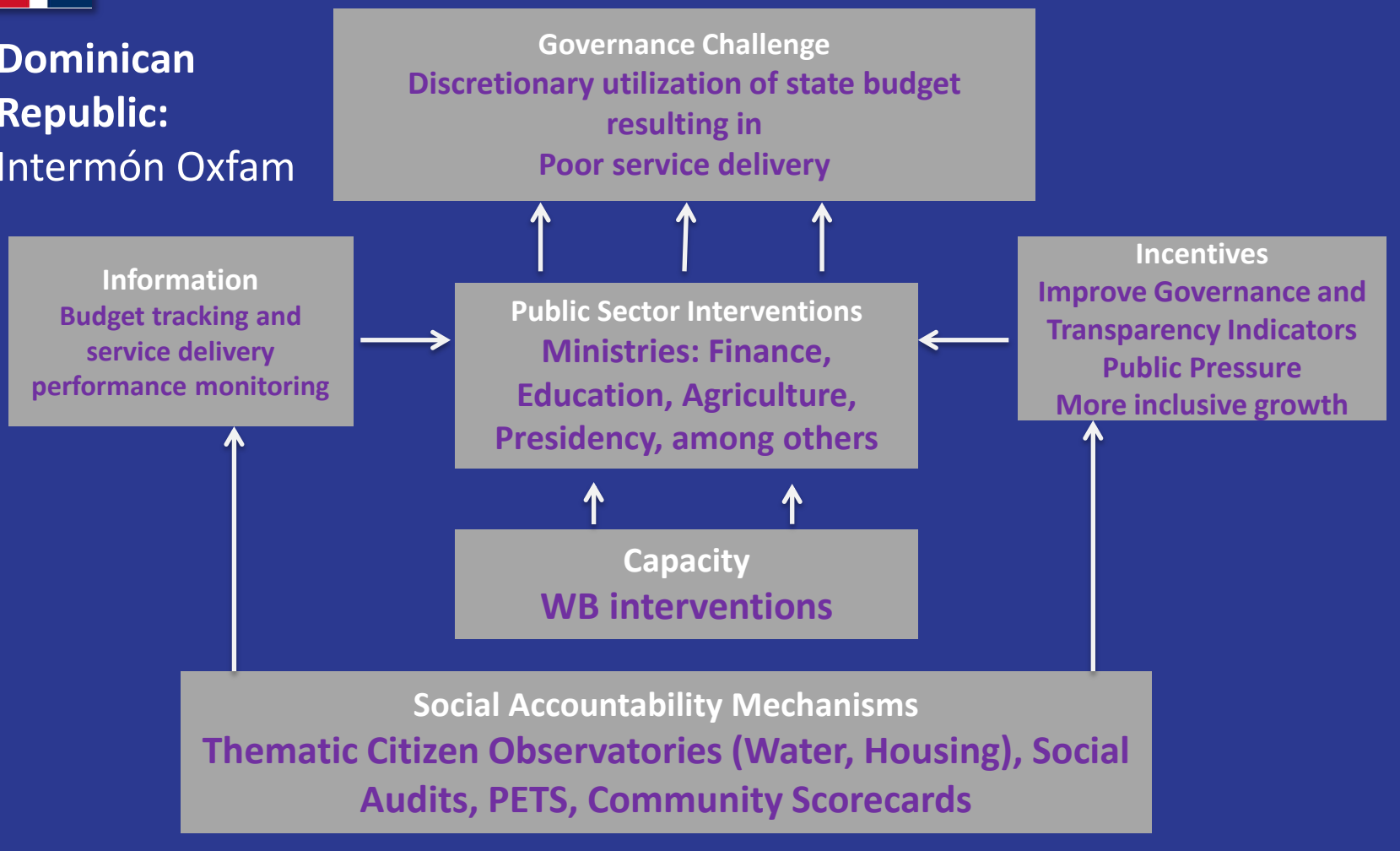

CFP Open: Wide Dissemination, Online Applications Platform

Eligibility Review at Country Level (by CMUs)

Technical Review by Roster of Experts

Secretariat Recommends Set of Proposals to Steering Committee

SC Approves Proposals on Non-Objection Basis

10-Day Period for Government + 5-Day Period for Public Comments

Fiduciary Assessment

Final Approval by Country Directors

Legal Agreement (OPEN DATA), WPA, Initiation of Activities, and Supervision
