- OCertain priorities among creditors
- oFlawed mechanism for the schemes of arrangement



## Still to be remedied – o/s shortcomings

- ORegulatory framework
  - OSpecialised insolvency judges
  - oEfficiency of Courts
  - OInconsistent interpretation of the law
  - OStrengthening the Code of Conduct for the IPs
- OSeveral non-key
  - ORemuneration for creditors participating in the creditors' committee
  - Threshold amount to file a petition
