Re: Sanctions Case No. 555 – Letter of Reprimand

Dear Respondent,

In its Decision No. 121 (the “Decision”), the Sanctions Board found that the record supported a conclusion that it was more likely than not that the Respondent had engaged in a collusive practice, as defined by the World Bank’s Guidelines: Procurement under IBRD Loans and IDA Credits (May 2004, revised October 1, 2006 and May 1, 2010).

The present letter shall serve as a reprimand for the Respondent’s collusive arrangement designed to influence the bidding processes and stifle open competition for a Bank-financed contract. In its determination of this sanction, the Sanctions Board took into account all applicable sanctioning factors, as stated in the Decision at Section V.C.

Pursuant to the Decision, this letter shall be posted on the World Bank’s website as of today for a period of six (6) months.
