Adopt a **diagnostic framework** at a national level and a city-level

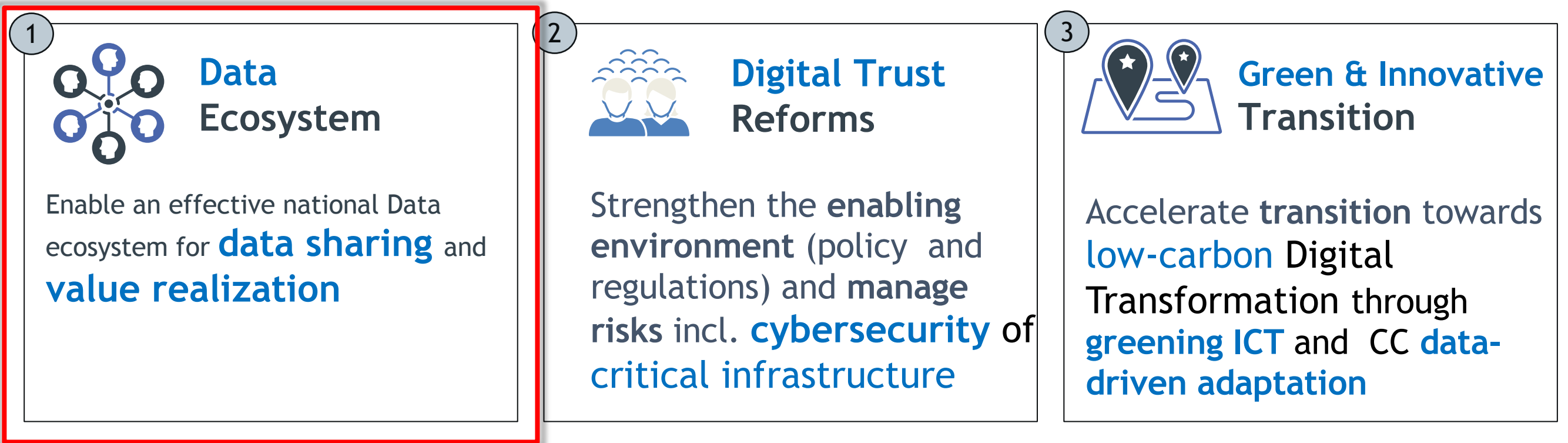

How a country should develop **human capital** to derive benefit from its data?



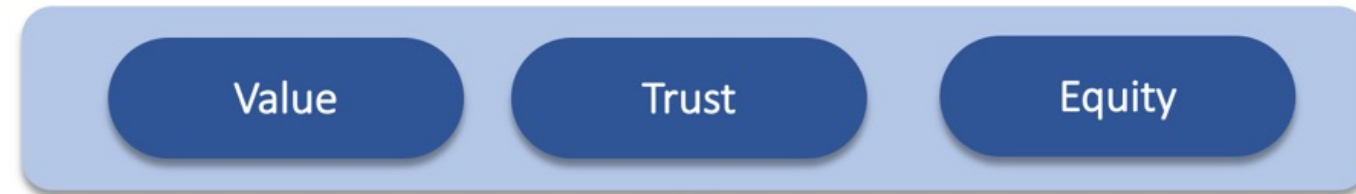

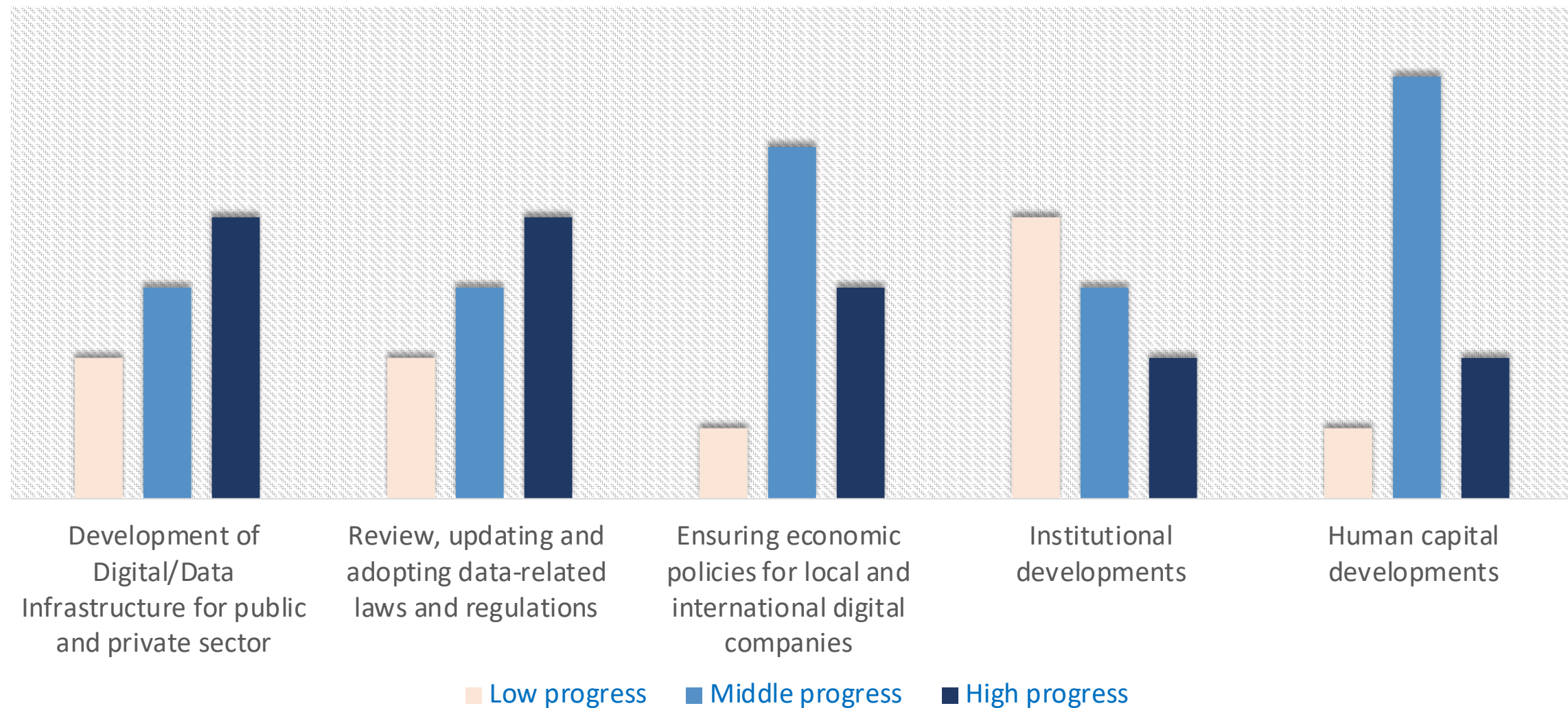

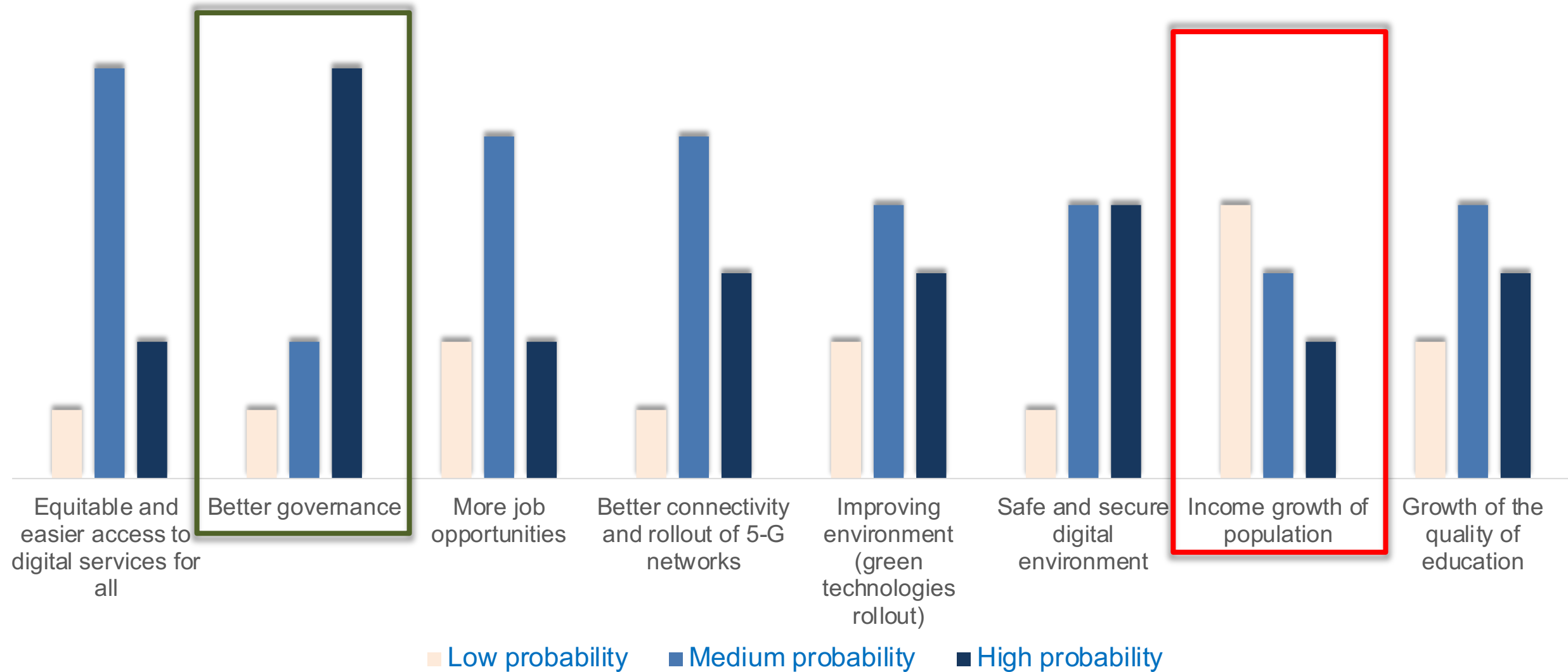
# HOW IS MOLDOVA BUILDING A NATIONAL DATA ECOSYSTEM: QUICK GLANCE

In which of the following areas Moldova has made substantial progress over the last five years?



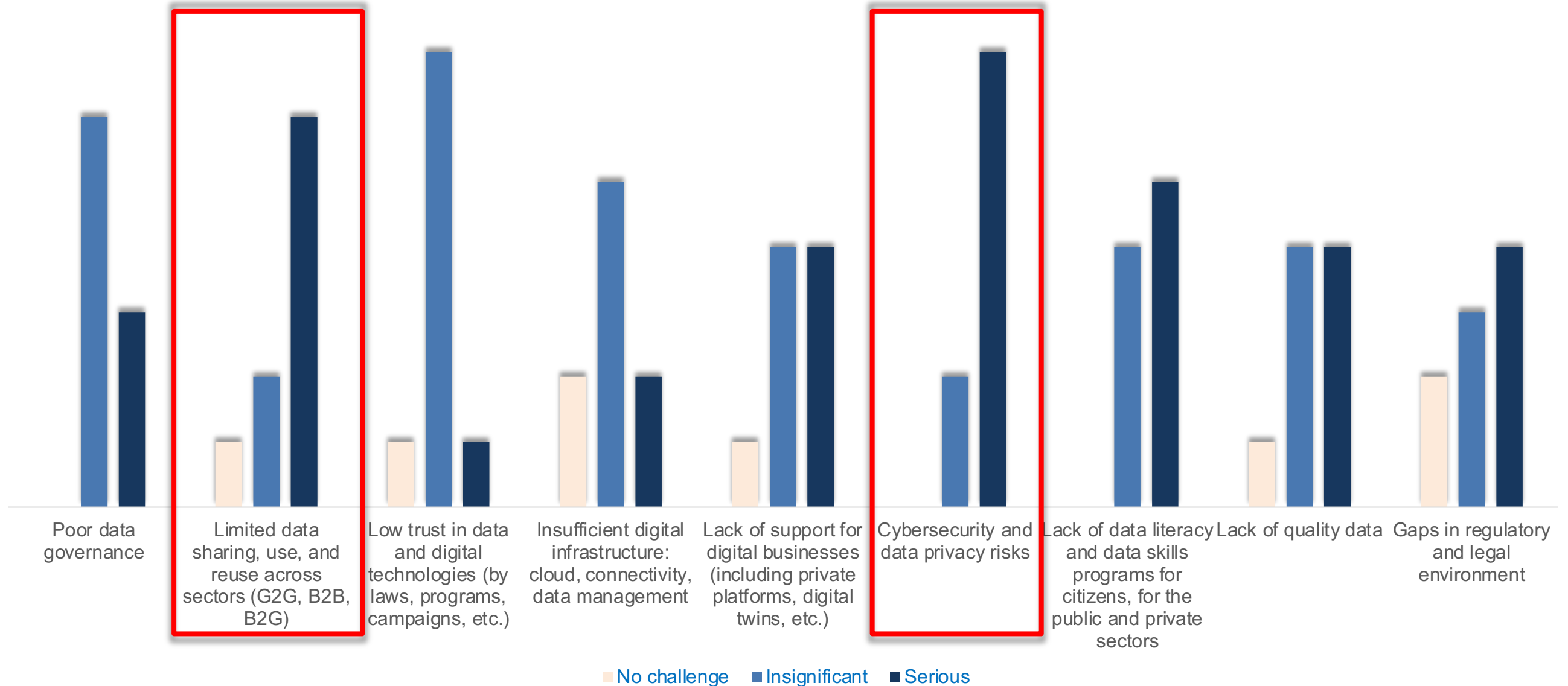

What are the benefits in having a data-driven development strategy in Moldova?



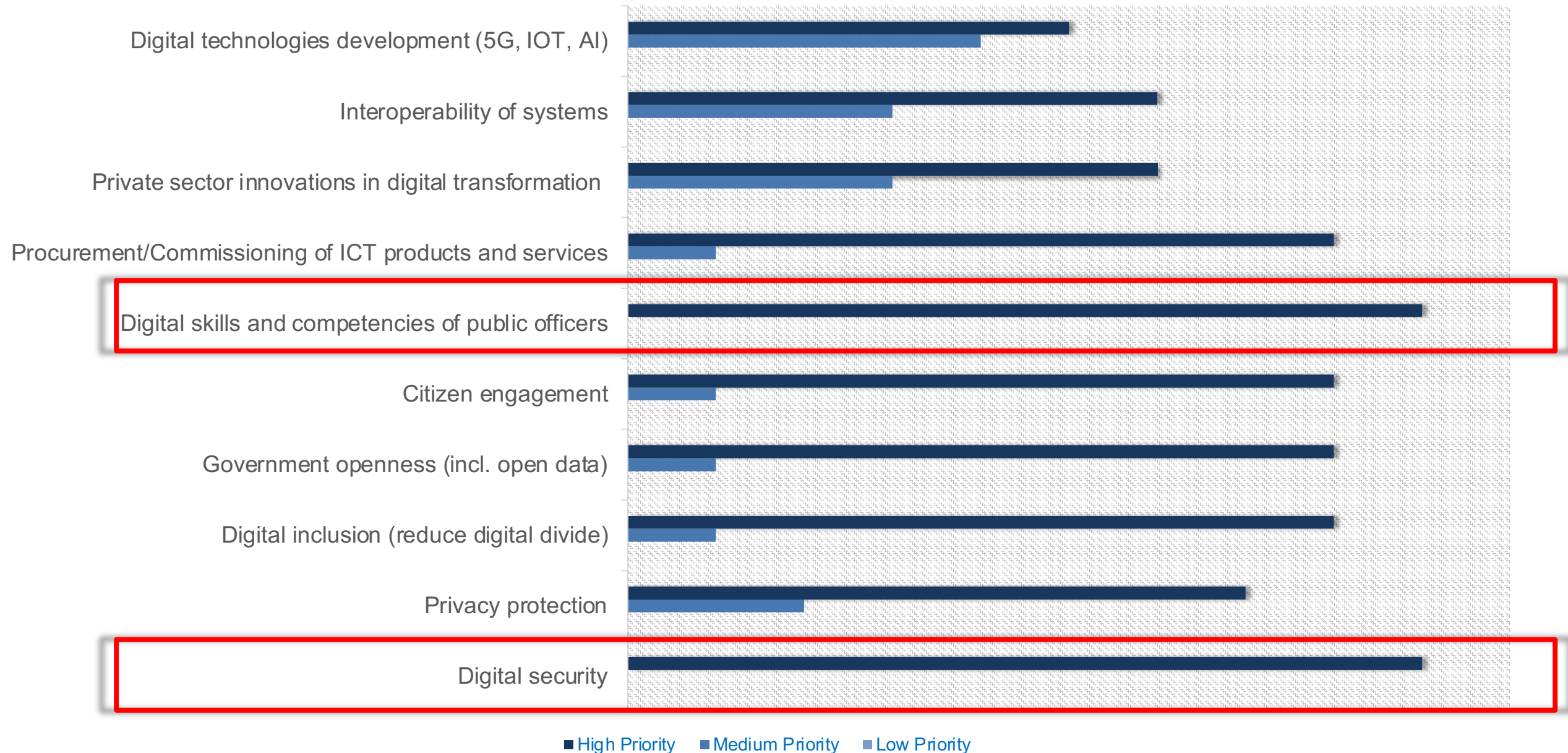

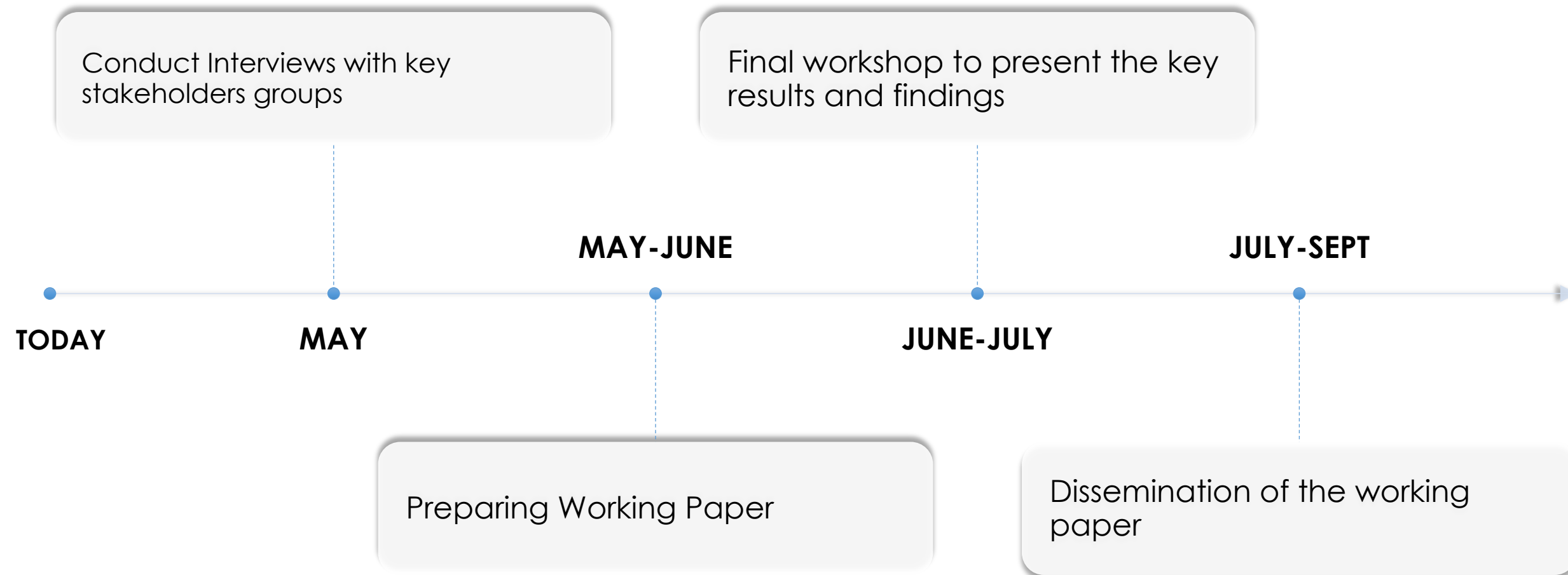
