## **Past CoP Events**

#### **Enabling BESS Series: Energy Storage for Power System Support**

First of three online events highlighting government actions to attract private investment and optimize benefits from BESS. This session featured example use cases of BESS with global examples from World Bank's experience, and a deep dive from IFC on a hybrid solar + BESS project in Uzbekistan representing a milestone for the region.



#### **Demystifying ESCOs and Energy Performance Contracts**

This online session aimed to clarify how ESCOs and EPCs operate and what lessons can be drawn by looking at ESCO experience from Czechia, Latvia and Armenia. The objective was to "demystify" ESCO models—exploring what makes them successful, and how they can be adapted to different market and policy contexts.



#### **RE Incentives & Tenders Series: Working With the Private Sector**

The second event in the online series highlighted best practices for attracting private sector interest in renewables. The session featured Poland's success in RE growth including addition of BESS, and how transparency in government planning and flexibility in auctions can facilitate optimized projects from qualified renewables developers.



#### Increasing Power Sector Resilience to Natural Disaster Risks in ECA Region

This knowledge-sharing event in Vienna brought together 35 participants from ECA ministries, system operators, and industry experts. The sessions focused on hazards to the power system particularly from floods and droughts and methods to boost resilience. Participants visited the Freudenau Hydropower Plant to see innovation at work.



#### Hydropower Modernization and Dam Design and Safety Technical Seminars

This series of two in-person technical seminars provided hydropower specialists from utilities and ministries the chance to build their capacity leveraging Austria's hydropower expertise. The first week-long seminar focused on Dam Safety and Design, and the second seminar focused on Dam Rehabilitation and Modernization.

#### IFC Supports Energy Resilience and Earthquake Reconstruction in Türkiye

IFC announced a landmark sustainability-linked loan to Enerjisa Enerji A.Ş., a leading private utility company in Türkiye. The aim is to refurbish the power distribution network impacted by the February 2023 earthquakes and modernize parts of the grid. Sustainability performance indicators include reducing distribution system losses and increasing women in senior management and leadership roles. Learn more from IFC.


#### **Re-Introducing the Energy Storage Europe Association**

Industry groups can contribute meaningfully to dialogue on policy and innovation. As the role of energy storage has grown, the Energy Storage Europe Association (rebranded after 15 years as EASE) is aiming to increase engagement and visibility around this









#### Piloting Near Zero Energy Building (NZEB) Retrofit

Croatia's Energy Institute Hrvoje Požar's building has undergone a retrofit to meet NZEB standards, including a 50 kW rooftop PV system covering 30% of its energy demand. The upgrade reduced heating and cooling energy costs by 65%, demonstrating the feasibility of NZEB retrofits. More details at Advancing Building **Energy Performance.** 

#### Maximizing Benefits with BESS4Hydro

In northern Italy, Enel Green Power is pioneering the combination of pumped reservoir hydropower with a 4 MW lithium-ion battery system. This BESS4Hydro project gives added flexibility in managing the energy produced with 2 hours of storage. The battery can also be charged from the grid to cover downtime and provides grid services as an integrated package. Learn more at BESS4Hydro.

Did you know that each \$1 invested in boosting the resilience of critical infrastructure such as power systems returns ~\$4 in benefits?

**Did you know** that the global ESCO performance contracting market is expected to double this decade to exceed **\$40 billion in 2030**, according to <u>Guidehouse Insights</u>?

<u>Demystifying ESCOs and Energy</u> <u>Performance Contracts</u> explored how this market is evolving in ECA region. Did you know that electricity generation from renewables exceeded generation from coal globally for the first time ever?
